

PSYCHIATRY SERVICES: EXCLUSION CRITERIA

The purpose of this document is to be transparent about the types of services **Mindara Modern Psychiatry LLC** (“Practice”) does and does not provide, so that individuals can determine whether our practice is the right fit for their needs **before scheduling an appointment**.

Services We Do Not Provide

The Practice does **not** provide the following services:

- Disability evaluations or disability-related documentation.
- Forensic psychiatric evaluations.
- Competency evaluations.
- Evaluations related to child custody or visitation disputes.
- Psychiatric evaluations for surgical clearance.
- Expert witness court testimony or legal expert opinions.
- Suboxone or methadone treatment.

Individuals We Are Unable to Serve

At this time, the Practice is unable to provide services to individuals who:

- Are currently under a mental health treatment commitment.
- Have dementia or are geriatric patients with complex medical conditions.
- Have a close personal or familial relationship with a current patient or employee of the Practice, due to potential conflicts of interest.

Conditions Outside the Scope of Our Practice

The Practice provides outpatient psychiatric care and medication management. We are **not a specialized treatment center** for certain conditions. Individuals whose **primary concern** is one of the following may be better served by a specialized provider:

- Eating disorders.
- Substance use disorders requiring specialized treatment programs.
- Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID).
- Chronic pain as the primary presenting concern.

We recognize that many individuals may experience overlapping symptoms. Determination of appropriateness for care is based on **clinical judgment** and the primary focus of treatment.

Important Note

This list is not exhaustive. Final determination of appropriateness for care is made by the clinician based on clinical judgment, scope of practice, and patient safety considerations.
